know your voting rights



People who have served time for a felony have the right to vote

Voting rights are restored once a person has served their sentence, and completed all supervised release, including probation and parole. (WV CODE 3-2-2; WV CONSTITUTION, ARTICLE 4-1)



Registering to vote is quick, easy and can be done online

Check your registration status, register to vote or update your information online at www.govotewv.com. The registration deadline is **October 18, 2016**.



You may vote during early voting or on Election Day

Voters may cast their general election ballot at their county's early voting location, between **October 26** and **November 5**, or on Election Day, **November 8**.
