*Jennings Randolph was a U.S. Senator from Harrison County, West Virginia, and the father of the 26th Amendment to the U.S. Constitution that lowered the voting age from 21 to 18 years old. Senator Randolph believed that if a U.S. citizen was old enough to fight and die for his/her country, then they were old enough to choose the leaders who were sending them to these conflicts.*
