Special election to authorize additional levies for the fiscal years beginning July 1, 2017, July 1, 2018, July 1, 2019, July 1, 2020 and July 1, 2021, for the purpose of providing for the operation of the following organizations in the following amounts:

Mercer County Economic Development Authority - (2018) \$235,000, (2019) \$237,350, (2020) \$239,724, (2021) \$242,121, (2022) \$244,542.

Mercer County Planning Commission - (2018) \$42,083, (2019) \$42,395, (2020) \$42,547, (2021) \$47,961, (2022) \$47,788.

Mercer County Infrastructure Development, Securement and Litter Control - (2018) \$340,000, (2019) \$343,400, (2020) \$346,834, (2021) \$350,302, (2022) \$353,805.

Mercer Health Department - (2018) \$170,000, (2019) \$171,700, (2020) \$173,417, (2021) \$175,151, (2022) \$176,903.

Southern Highlands Community Mental Health Center - (2018) \$85,000, (2019) \$85,850, (2020) \$86,709, (2021) \$87,576, (2022) \$88,452.

Mercer County Commission for:

Mercer County Facilities Improvements - (2018) \$250,000, (2019) \$252,500, (2020) \$255,025, (2021) \$257,575, (2022) \$260,151.

Mercer County Office of Emergency Services - (2018) \$325,000, (2019) \$328,250, (2020) \$331,533, (2021) \$334,848, (2022) \$338,196.

Mercer County Parks and Recreation Department/Facility - (2018) \$190,000, (2019) \$191,900, (2020) \$193,819, (2021) \$195,757, (2022) \$197,715.

Totals - (2018) \$1,637,083, (2019) \$1,653,345, (2020) \$1,669,608, (2021) \$1,691,291, (2022) \$1,707,552

In the event any of these entities or agencies would cease to exist, for whatever reason, the funding allocated to said entity or agency may be utilized by the Mercer County Parks and Recreation Department for program operations and/or by the Mercer County Commission for capital improvement projects at county owned facilities covered by this levy order.

According to the Order of the Mercer County Commission, adopted on July 29, 2016. The funds raised will be used for providing adequate funding to operate the aforesaid organizations.

The additional levy, allowing for 4% delinquencies and 2.5% discount, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2017, shall be on Class I property 3.02 cents; and on Class II property 6.04 cents; and on Class III and Class IV property 12.08 cents; per \$100.00 valuation.

The additional levy, allowing for 4% delinquencies and 2.5% discount, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018, shall be on Class I property 3.05 cents; and on Class II property 6.10 cents; and on Class III and Class IV property 12.20 cents; per \$100.00 valuation.

The additional levy, allowing for 4% delinquencies and 2.5% discount, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019, shall be on Class I property 3.08 cents; and on Class II property 6.16 cents; and on Class III and Class IV property 12.32 cents; per \$100.00 valuation.

The additional levy, allowing for 4% delinquencies and 2.5% discount, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020, shall be on Class I property 3.12 cents; and on Class II property 6.22 cents; and on Class III and Class IV property 12.44 cents; per \$100.00 valuation.

The additional levy, allowing for 4% delinquencies and 2.5% discount, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021, shall be on Class I property 3.15 cents; and on Class II property 6.28 cents; and on Class III and Class IV property 12.56 cents; per \$100.00 valuation.

That in the event the separate and aggregate assessed valuation of each class of taxable property within the County of Mercer increases during the term of the special levy, the levy rate shall be adjusted so that the projected tax collection will be a maximum of \$1,637,083 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2017; a maximum of \$1,653,345 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018; a maximum of \$1,669,608 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019; a maximum of \$1,691,291 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020; and a maximum of \$1,707,552 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021.
