BOARD OF EDUCATION LEVY

Election to Authorize Additional Levies According to the Order of The Board of Education of the County of Randolph entered on February 16, 2016

An election to authorize levies for the fiscal years beginning July 1, 2016, July 1, 2017 and July 1, 2018 in the total amount of \$1,960,000 annually, for the purpose and approximate amounts for which such funds are needed, as follows:

PURPOSE FOR WHICH FUNDS ARE NEEDED.

Maintenance of Buildings and Grounds - Including summer program salaries, painting, paving, equipment, vehicle replacement, roof replacement, building repairs (fire code inspections/corrections, ADA and SBA deficiencies) and supplies (buildings, grounds and equipment).

\$400,000

HVAC Additions and Improvements - Including a contract for upkeep of the county HVAC systems and equipment replacement.

\$200,000

Instructional - Including student supplies, instructional materials and equipment, furnishings, copier contract and supplies, attendance/graduation/drop-out prevention initiatives and extended school opportunities.

\$345,000

Educational Opportunities - Including educational field trips, presentations and performances, positive behavior intervention support rewards, and transportation cost (county fair, forest festival, outdoor education, etc.).

\$75,000

Arts - Including music, band, choir, art club, band/choir, and Artsbank.

\$100,000

Technology - Including computers, printers, software, hardware, repairs and support staff.

\$500,000

Activities/Extracurricular - Including student insurance and athletics including uniforms, transportation and equipment.

\$00,000

Library - Support of the 5 county libraries

\$40,000

Capital Improvements - Including projects for which School Building Authority matching funds are sought and/or obtained, new construction, facility additions and renovations to, in or for the public schools.

\$200,000

TOTAL \$1,960,000

The proposed rate of levy in cents (per \$100 of assessed value) on each class of property within Randolph County School District for the fiscal years beginning July 1, 2016, July 1, 2017 and July 1, 2018, is as follows:

- Class I 5.66¢
Class II 11.32¢
Class III 22.64¢
Class IV 22.64¢

The total amount necessary to carry out the above purposes, after making reasonable allowances for accounts, delinquencies and exonerations, is \$5,860,000, or the sum of \$1,960,000 annually.

In the event The Board of Education of the County of Randolph shall obtain additional money by grants, otherwise from the state or federal government, or from any agency of either, or from any other source, for the purposes intended, such additional money may be used either in substitution for, or in addition to, the sum obtained from such additional levies as The Board of Education of the County of Randolph may from time to time determine.

The Board of Education of the County of Randolph is hereby authorized and empowered to expend, during the term of this levy and one additional year, the surplus, if any, accruing during the term of this levy in excess of the amounts needed for any of the above-stated purposes, but shall spend such surplus for capital improvements including potential projects for which School Building Authority matching funds are sought and/or obtained, new construction, facility additions and renovations to, in, or for the public schools.

Those favoring the levies shall mark after "For the Levies"; those against such levies shall mark after "Against the Levies."
