An election to authorize additional levies for the year beginning July 1, 2017 and July 1, 2018 and July 1, 2019 and July 1, 2020 and July 1, 2021 for the purpose of providing sufficient local funding to The Tri-State Transit Authority (TTA) to continue bus service to the City of Huntington entered on the 28th day of December, 2015.

The additional levy shall be Class I property 3.5 cents; on Class II property 7 cents; on Class IV property 14 cents per \$100 of assessed valuation. Provided, that, in the event the separate and aggregate assessed valuation of each class of taxable property within the City of Huntington increases during the term of this special levy, the levy rate may be adjusted so that the projected gross tax revenue will not

exceed 104% of the previous year's projected gross tax revenue. However, in no event shall the levy rate be adjusted so that the projected gross tax revenue is less than 104% of the previous year's projected gross tax revenue, unless the assessed valuations produce total revenue in an amount less than 104% of the said previous year's projected gross tax revenue. An increase in the aggregate assessed valuation of each class of taxable property due to new construction or improvements to existing real property, including beginning recovery of natural resources and newly acquired personal property, shall not be included in calculating the new tax levy for the purposes of this Section.
