- File with the **Secretary of State** if you are a candidate (or a committee, person or agent supporting candidates) for an office on the ballot in more than one county or legislative office.
- File with the **county clerk** if you are a candidate (or a committee, person or agent supporting candidates) for county office or non-legislative office entirely within a county.
- File with the **municipal recorder** if you are a candidate (or a committee, person or agent supporting candidates) running for city office.
