

ELECTION LAW VIOLATIONS BY A VOTER

- Attempting to vote more than once
- Voting when disqualified
 - Not registered to vote
 - Not a citizen of US or WV
 - Underage
 - Under conviction
- Voting in wrong precinct or county
- Misrepresenting identity at polling place
- Absentee voting by mail when not entitled
- Requesting assistance when not entitled
- Selling vote
- Recording or photographing vote

VIOLATIONS BY PERSONS OTHER THAN VOTER THAT ATTEMPT TO INFLUENCE VOTE OR RESULT

- Electioneering at polling place (or w/i 300 feet)
- Providing unrequested assistance to voter
- Advertising for, or against, candidate without proper reporting
- Anonymous publication in support of, or opposition to, candidate
- Tampering with official ballots, machines, or equipment
- Unauthorized possession of official ballots
- Harassment or intimidation of right to vote
- Buying votes
- Marking or voting someone else's ballot
- Soliciting votes by municipal/county/state employees at place of work
- Soliciting financial contributions from municipal/county/state employees anywhere
- Promising employment in exchange for political activity
- Discriminating against employee due to employee's political activity
- Discriminating against persons due to race/gender/age/impairment/religion
- Individual contribution of more than \$1,000
- Cash contribution of more than \$50
- Expending campaign funds for purposes other than listed in §3-8-9
